Equipment

Learning and Teaching in Term 1

Reading in Term 1 will introduce the children to new comprehension strategies such as finding the meanings of unknown words, summarising, inferring from the text and developing a picture of characters and settings in our heads. In Writing, we will develop our skills in creating and describing interesting characters and structuring our stories using paragraphs. We will also learn how to write recounts of events and we will be taking advantage of National Poetry Day to write and share our own poems.

In Maths, we will be developing our knowledge of place value and learning new strategies to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems, both mentally and as formal sums. We will also be learning how to tell the time on analogue and digital clocks, use calendars and timetables to organise ourselves and convert between seconds, minutes and hours. Scotland's Maths week is also this term and so we will be celebrating that with lots of engaging Maths activities and challenges.

This term, we will be using the context of Walt Disney to explore issues of friendship, growth mindset, worries and acceptance of others through engagement with some of his stories. We will also use this context to develop our drawing skills in Art, understanding of pitch and tone in Music and we will develop our skills in creating a timeline using his main films and life events. I apologise in advance for any songs which make their way home and end up stuck in your head!
