Classwork

This term we will be focusing on using our knowledge of the sounds letters make and how we can blend these sounds together to read and write with some more independence. We will be focusing on how to use finger spaces to help present our writing and when reading we will be talking lots about the characters in stories as well as important events and predicting what might happen next. We will be exploring how to tell the time using o'clock and the class will also be looking at how they can use their existing counting skills to help them complete simple addition questions.

Our topic this term is **The 5 Senses**. We will be learning about the senses and how we use them.

Homework

Your child's homework will be handed out on a **Wednesday** and should be returned the following **Tuesday**. Homework tasks will reinforce what your child has been learning in class. Once completed please sign your child's homework task.

Reading books, home/school diary and common words cases should be kept separate in your child's book bag and not handed in with the homework folder.
