Topic / Classwork

Our topic this term is Our Senses and Christmas. We will be learning all about our senses and how we use these. We will be looking at the Christmas story and how it is celebrated. This term we will be focusing on using our knowledge of the sounds. We will look at how we can blend these sounds together to read and write with some independence. We will be focusing on how to use finger spaces to help present our writing and when reading we will be talking lots about the characters in stories as well as important events and predicting what might happen next. We will continue to look at numbers and begin to look at addition in numbers. We will have a focus on some time and do some data handling.

It is lovely to hear about all the classes achievements outside of school. I will encourage this to be kept to a Friday when I will have a focus time called Show

and Share when children can share this with the rest of the class. Please do share all the little milestones. It is lovely to hear what the boys and girls can do.
