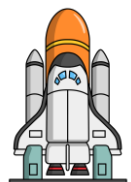

Our class learning

Class Project – Space

We will be finding out about how gravity works and how the moon and earth orbit the sun. We shall look at our solar system and the history of space exploration. Through finding out about the stars and considering the wider universe, we will discuss the possibilities of alien life forms. The children have been sharing what they know already and their questions relating to our topic. Through research, demonstrations and experiments we hope to find the answers to these questions.



Literacy

Reading homework will continue to be given every week with a focus on understanding the words, facts and stories that we read. We will be focusing on writing imaginative stories with characters and setting using our Read, Write, Count packs for inspiration. (These are packs given out by the Scottish Government which have fun reading, writing and maths activities for children. They will be sent home later on in the term.)

Maths – Number and Money

I can use money to pay for items and can work out how much change I should receive. MNU 1-09a

I have explored symmetry in my own and the wider environment and can create and recognise symmetrical pictures, patterns and shapes. MTH 1-19a



We shall be focusing on identifying, combining and using money. This will include finding change from different amounts and working within a budget.

Moving on from Money, we shall be exploring symmetry and building our understanding of lines of symmetry.
