<u>In class</u>



Our topic this term is 'Extreme Earth. This topic explores the causes and impact of natural disasters around the world as well as what is done in terms of aid to help countries hit. The children will make connections between natural disasters and the changes we have seen in weather locally, making reference to global warming and the effect it has.

- I can describe the physical processes of a natural disaster and discuss its impact on people and the landscape. SOC 2-07b
- I can report and comment on current scientific news items to develop my knowledge and understanding of topical science. SCN 2-20b

We will be focusing on discursive writing, writing procedures and imaginative writing this term, looking at writer's craft. Our maths will focus on various aspects of numeracy including fractions, decimals and percentages, money, time, expressions and equations. These will be dependent on the children's strengths and areas for development. Consistent revision of multiplication facts and division at home will really assist in strengthening these other areas. The children will continue to work with Mrs. Jones and Mrs. Paterson for spelling and problem solving if they did so in term 1.
