Applicants should be confident in the water without flotation aids and be able to perform at least:

- 1 length (25m) each of front crawl, backstroke • and breaststroke for 7-8 year olds
- 2 lengths (50m) for 9-10 year olds
- 4 lengths (100m) for 11 year olds.
- Applicants should have completed Level 5 swimming lessons or equivalent.
