Parking with Consideration

The recent bad weather meant rather than look for a space, or walk a short distance, some inconsiderate parking caused difficulties or even danger for others.

- Refrain from parking in the bus and disability bays. You are breaking the law if you do so unless you have a permit.
- Park within the outlined bays - do not take two spaces.
- Please keep your speed down and watch out for children near the crossing areas.

Playground - Arrival and Dismissal

Please note that the playground is for pupils only and as the P1 children settle in parents should start to keep to the outside of the playground ensuring the entrances are clear for pupils to enter.

Please note the following:

- P1 and P2 pupils will line up in the quad.
- Younger pre-school children should not enter or play in the playground
- To ensure all pupils go home immediately on dismissal we ask that all pupils do not access the Adventure Playground. Similarly this area

should not be used by school or pre-school children prior to 9.00 am.

- Please can we remind you to keep dogs well away from the playground and entrances. We recently had a report of someone nipped on the leg by a dog beside the playground fence.

We appreciate that all of the above sounds restrictive but we do want to ensure children can enter the playground freely and that all have left school safely. A few parents have let us know how difficult it is and how anxious their children are when trying to get through all the adults crowding around the entrances to the playground or when dogs are there.
