Parental Expectations - Communication

Unfortunately, we have had occasions of repeat phone calls from parents within short periods of time within a single school day and other, demanding behaviours regarding return calls and meetings with staff members. Whilst this is very much an infrequent occurrence, I ask that all parents be aware of how busy and hardworking the school staff are for the best outcomes for all learners.

It will not always be possible to immediately see or speak with a member of the School Leadership Team or a Class Teacher. School Office staff will inform parents of likely timescales (where information is available) for a return call at the point of request.

We endeavour to get back to parents quickly and will prioritise urgent matters; maintaining a solution focused approach.

Thank you to all our parents, pupils and school community members who have entered into a cooperative, positive partnership; promoting appropriate values in all interactions.

Bicycles and Scooters

All pupils have been reminded that bicycles and scooters should be stored at the Bike Racks during the school day.

Bicycles and scooters left elsewhere (e.g. against the trees beside the astroturf) are likely to be moved to the Bike Racks.

Poly Tunnel in the School Garden

Due to recent and ongoing vandalism, and other anti-social behaviours occurring in the Poly Tunnel in the school garden, it is proposed that the shelter provided by the polythene layer be removed.

This is currently being considered along with plans to develop the use of the garden further.

Our Nursery and primary pupils, along with members of the Kintore Kids Club, have been making great use of the garden and it is a shame to have their good work spoilt by the actions of a few.

Lost Property

The School Office is handed a large amount of lost property. This includes (but is not limited to) wallets/purses, phones, bank cards, spectacles and keys. The School Office will hold items handed in for a period of two months before handing over to Police Scotland's Inverurie Police Station.

Pupils clothing, lunchboxes and toys or small items (e.g. pencils, rulers) relating to children will continue to be held in school.

Temporary Classroom (Hut) Removal

It has been confirmed with the school that Hut 1 which currently provides temporary classroom facilities to P4K and P4P will be removed during the summer holidays.

Planning for class composition and classroom allocation are already well underway to accommodate this change to the school estate.

Parking

We continue to have reports of inconsiderate and dangerous parking. All parents and visitors to the school are asked to use marked parking spaces only and observe the Bus Stop and Disabled Parking bays appropriately.
