#### Context for Learning

This term, our context for learning will be 'Mary Queen of Scots'. The children will be learning about the story of Scotland's most famous queen: battles, murder, plotting, romance, kidnap, imprisonment, escape and execution. We will be identifying and investigating some of the key sites associated with Mary in Scotland. It is even believed that Mary Queen of Scots even visited our very own Hallforest Castle in 1562. As part of our context for learning we hope to visit Holyrood Castle for a workshop on Mary Queen of Scots.

#### Literacy

In Writing we will begin the term by working on writing a narrative developing interesting introductions, and conclusions, appropriate settings and vocabulary to engage/influence the reader as well as using turning points and cliff hangers. We will also be working on our Persuasive writing and Newspaper reports developing our ability to express thoughts and opinions in our writing using some supporting detail and evidence to persuade our reader. In Reading we will be improving our ability to skim, scan and close read a passage as well as reading and giving book reviews. In Listening and Talking we will be identifying and discussing the impact of a range of punctuation, discussing atmosphere, tension and characterisation and linking examples from texts to our own and other's experiences. In Grammar we will be looking at literacy devices to build cohesion within a paragraph, linking paragraphs using adverbials of time, place and number and the use of commas after fronted adverbials.

#### Numeracy

In Maths we will be working on multiplication and division including calculations using grid and column methods. We will also be covering multiples, factors, primes, powers and roots and tackling algebraic equations. We will be having a workshop from the Money Sense school programme from RBS. The workshop involves the children being Fraud Squad Investigators who have to solve a fraud which had been committed against their friend. They then have to create and present a report warning other of the dangers of identity theft and fraud. #### Health and Well-Being

Through our weekly Senior Assemblies are continuing to build our Decider Skills which aim to provide children with the skills to recognise their own thoughts, feelings and behaviours, and to monitor and manage their own emotions and mental health. We will have a visit from the ALEC
